

PARADISE LAKE IMPROVEMENT BOARD

SUMMARY OF MARCH 16, 2011

Meeting called to order at 7:00 P.M. Minutes from February 9 and February 23 meetings were approved.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

FoPL Vice President Rosemary Consani told the LIB that after listening to the presentations on 2/23/2011, the community meeting on 3/7/2011, and after several members did some research on the Laminar Flow System that the FoPL fully supported and would stand behind Lake Shore Environmental and Clean Flow. She told the LIB that we were very impressed with the Laminar Flow System and felt that this was the answer to clean up our lake in an environmentally safe manner.

PLA President Marilyn Smith stated that the PLA supported further investigation into the Laminar Flow System.

COMMUNICATIONS:

1. Included a legal opinion from Olson, Bzdok, & Howard that LSSU/ECT could present their proposal.
2. John Tucci sent a PDF of the March 7th presentation.
3. C. Freebairn forwarded a power point presentation from Indian Lake where the Laminar Flow System has been use.
4. Letter from John O'Meara (ECT) concerning a correspondence received by LSSU.
5. Article from Jennifer Jones (LEI) on EWM and sediment nutrients
6. 24 e-mails and 4 traditional letters – most of which supported the Laminar Flow System

Jim Tamlyn said that it was good to see that the FoPL and PLA had both agreed with the Laminar Flow System – at which time Marilyn Smith said that they were not supporting it just supporting further investigation of the system.

OLD BUSINESS:

Bill from the insurance for just under \$2,000 for insurance to cover the LIB members.

NEW BUSINESS:

It was decided not to consider the proposal from LSSU/ECT since they sent their proposal in late.

C. Freebairn stated that she would support either Lake Shore or Progressive A/E. Jim Tamlyn agreed. C. Freebairn made a motion to except the Progressive A/E proposal. She stated that she had spoken with someone from Progressive and that person felt that the time schedule could be moved up from the original proposal. The LIB agreed to inform Progressive that the community and the LIB were very interested in the Laminar Flow System.

The board was asked why the LIB would consider hiring a company who has already said this system would not work in Paradise Lake. The Board said that Progressive would have to do as they were directed to do.

A question was asked why they wouldn't hire the company that brought the Laminar Flow System to the table – that we would not even be aware of it if not for Lake Shore. Elaine Bostwick said that she felt that LEI was too expensive as well as John Tucci from Clean Flow and felt that they could get the same services somewhere else. Several members of the audience stated that “you get what you pay for”.

A vote was taken and the vote was 4 – 0 for hiring Progressive A/E. They will try to get them to come to the next meeting on April 13, 2011.
